Farm Rescue Awarded \$100,000 Grant from Otto Bremer Trust

Trust continues its strong support of rural families in crisis

HORACE, N.D., February 13, 2018 - Farm Rescue, a nonprofit organization that provides planting, having and hay hauling assistance free of charge to farm and ranch families who have experienced a major illness, injury or natural disaster, received a grant totaling \$100,000 from the Otto Bremer Trust.

Farm Rescue just completed its busiest year to date, with over 125 farm and ranch families receiving assistance from the nonprofit's Angels in Blue volunteers. The organization also reached another milestone by assisting its 500th family since operations first began in 2006.
