Farm Rescue Receives \$250,000 Grant from Engelstad Family Foundation *Funds represent Engelstad Family Foundation's support for farm and ranch families*

HORACE, N.D., June 5, 2018 - Farm Rescue, a nonprofit organization that provides planting, harvesting, haying and hay hauling assistance free of charge to farm and ranch families who have experienced a major illness, injury or natural disaster, received a grant totaling \$250,000 from the Engelstad Family Foundation.
