Hess Corporation Furthers Support of Farm Rescue with \$50,000 Donation

Contribution will bolster nonprofit's assistance efforts for farm families in crisis

HORACE, N.D., September 2, 2021 - Farm Rescue, a nonprofit organization that provides planting, haying, harvest and livestock feeding assistance free of charge to farm and ranch families who have experienced a major illness, injury or natural disaster, received \$50,000 in donated funds from Hess Corporation.
